

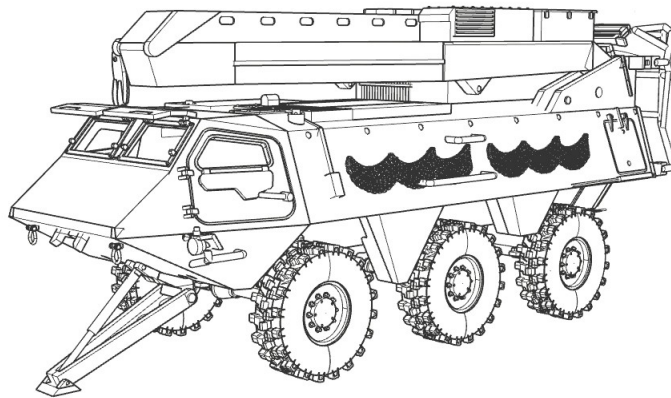

Sisu xa-182 M87M Jantronic J-1000 radar

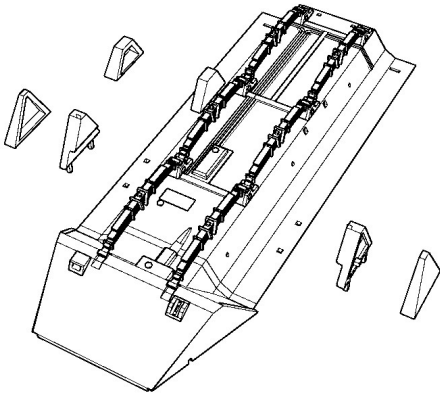
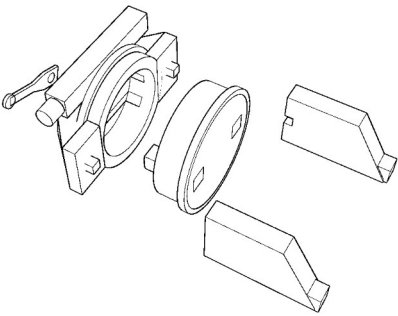
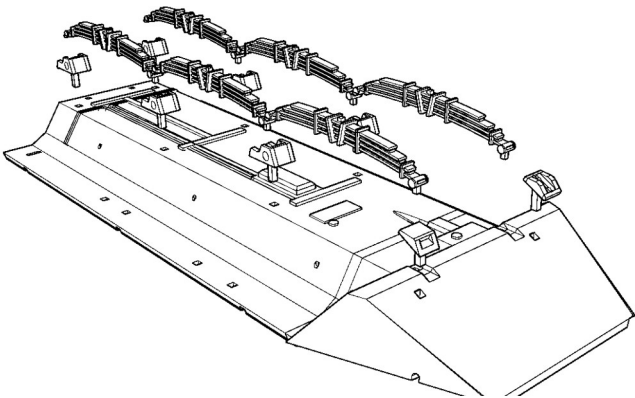
Sisu xa-182 is equipped with Jantronic J-1000 radar. This vehicle is based on Sisu xa-180 vehicle.

This kit do not have correct registration number, because FDF asked me not to use correct registration numbers on special vehicles

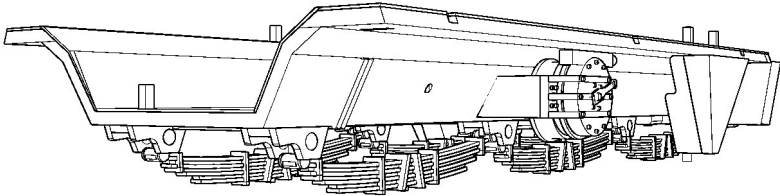
This kit is not suitable for kids under 15 years



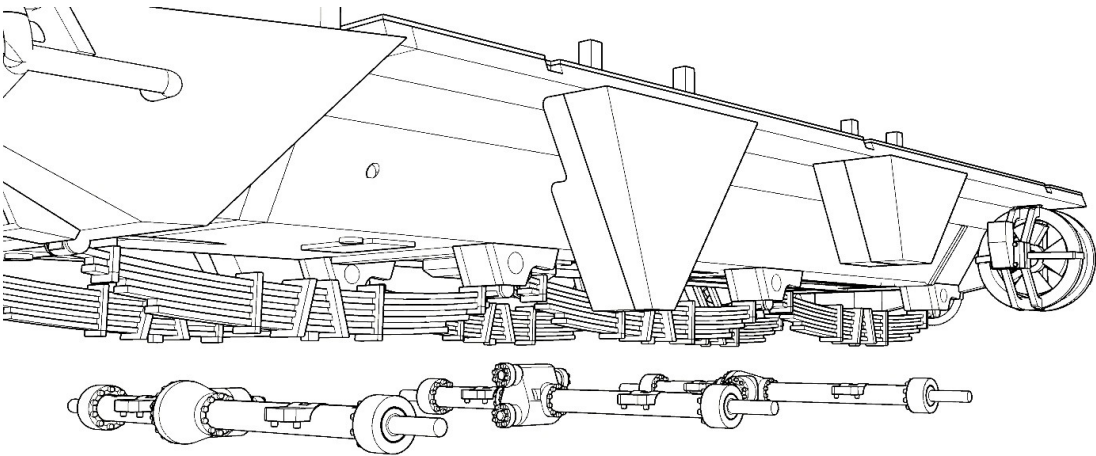

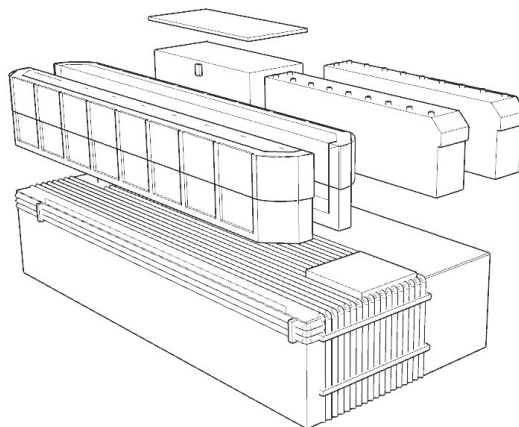


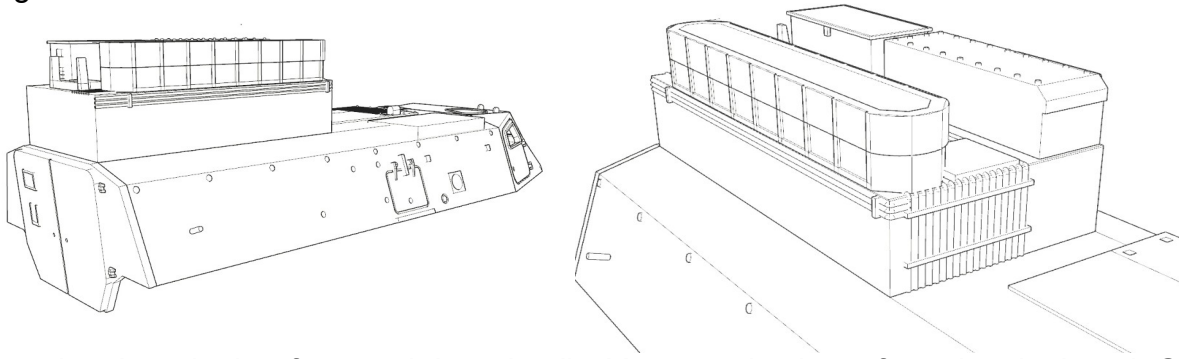


Support leg, front. Notice, there are two different ways to do it.

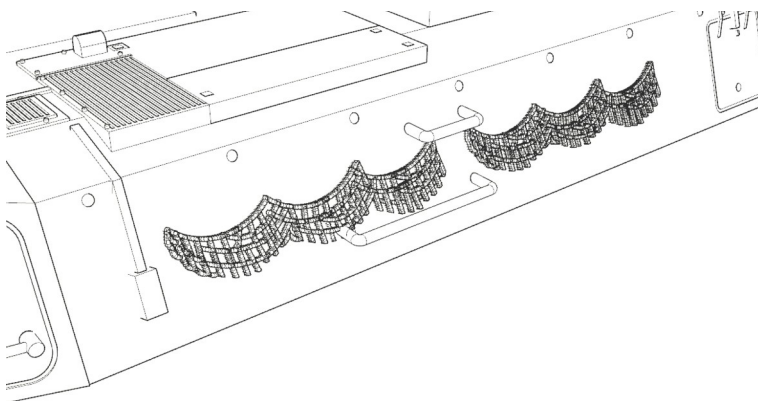
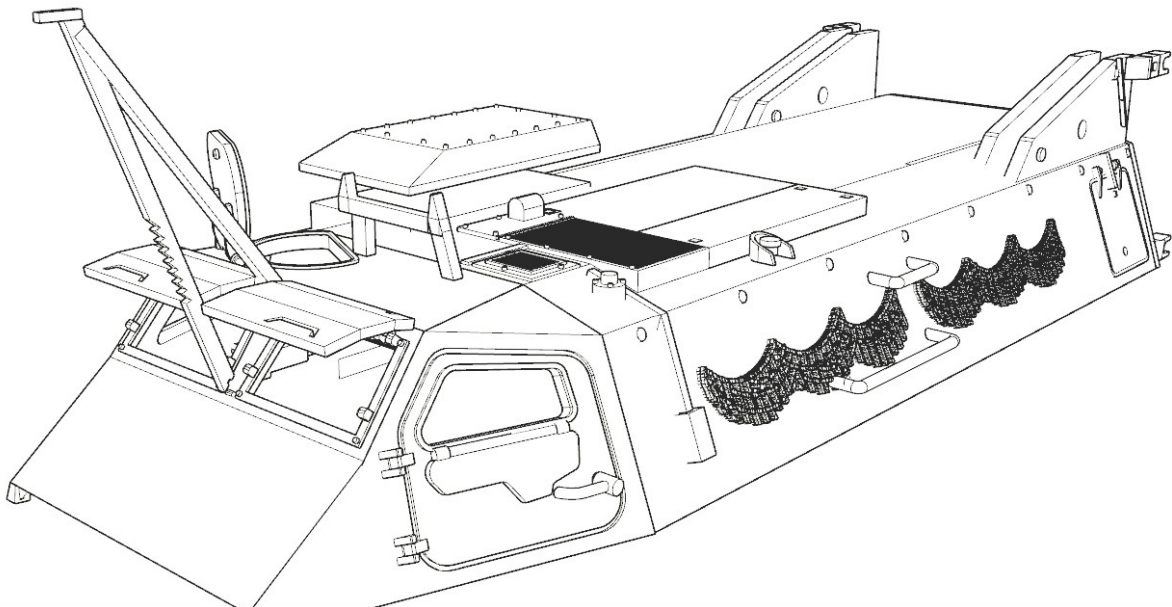

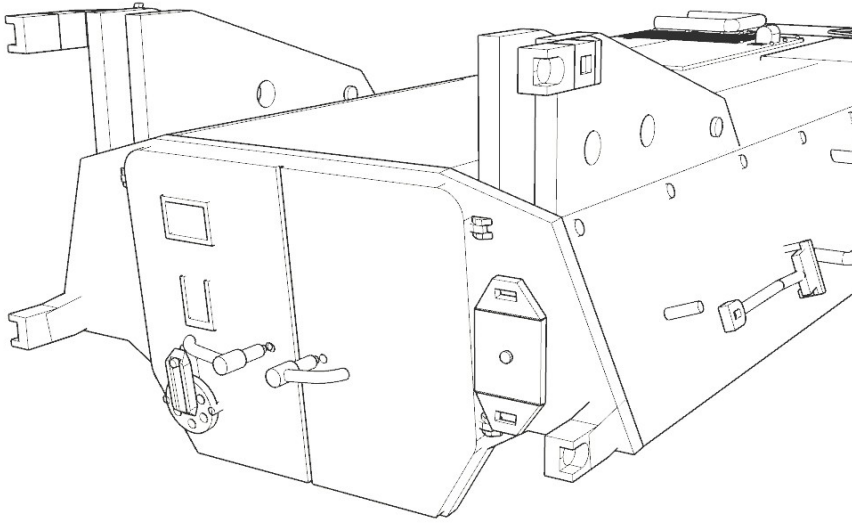




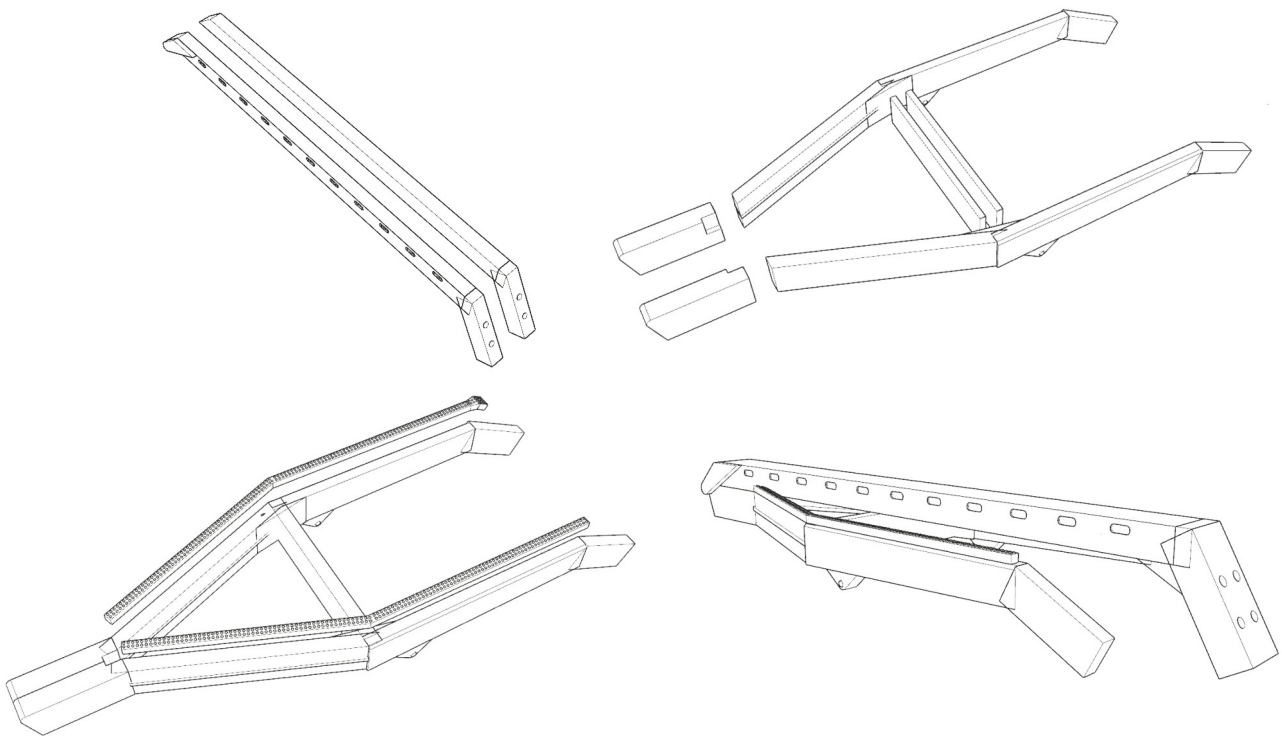
Front hatch and other front and door details. You can also have front hatch closed. Glue hatch AFTER you have built **lift arm**, so you will see how it fits. Notice that chains are **only on one side**. Cut chains shorter! Add wire cutter, gas cap, antenna holder



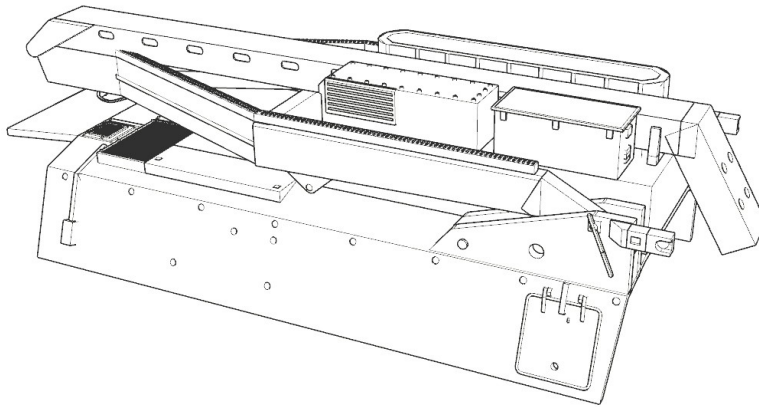
NOTICE, that there are wire in small plastic bag for steps



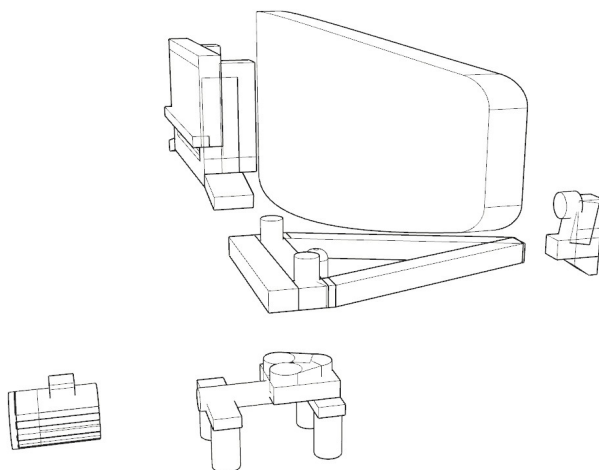
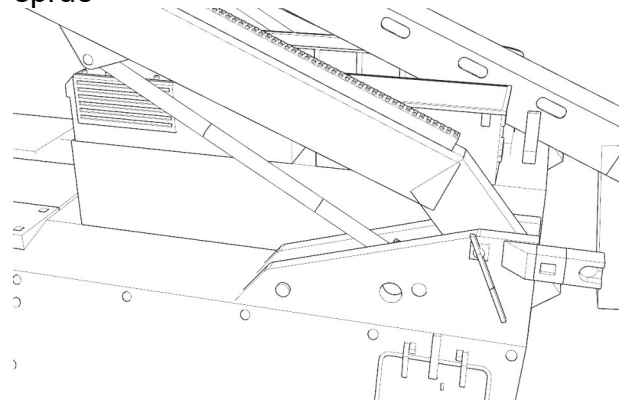
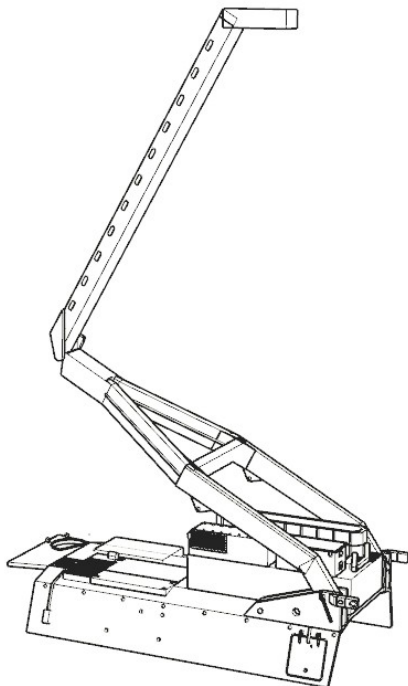
Beam 1 Glue parts together



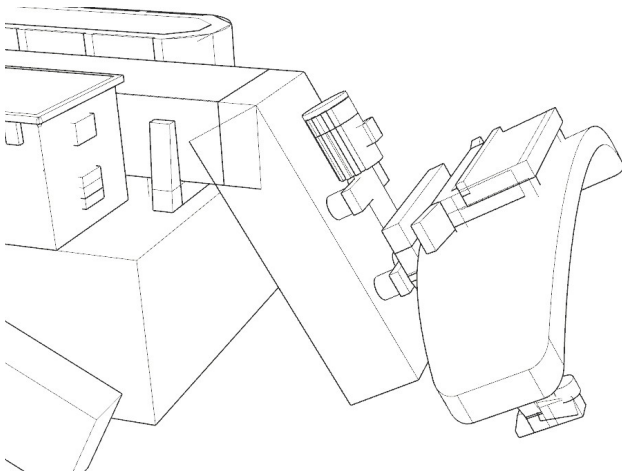
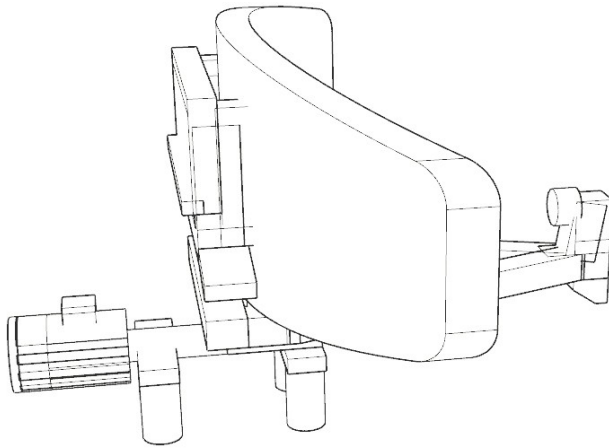
This is how lift is under transportation, but when operating, it is as on shown on next picture. Make sure that top of the beam is on horizontally. Also supporting legs are down.



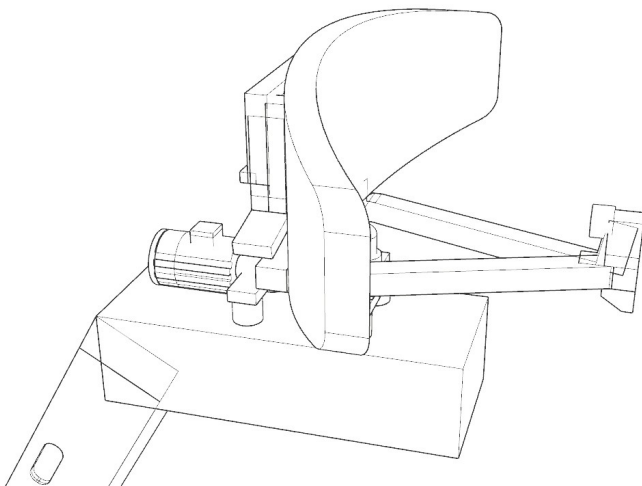
There you can see difference.

sprue



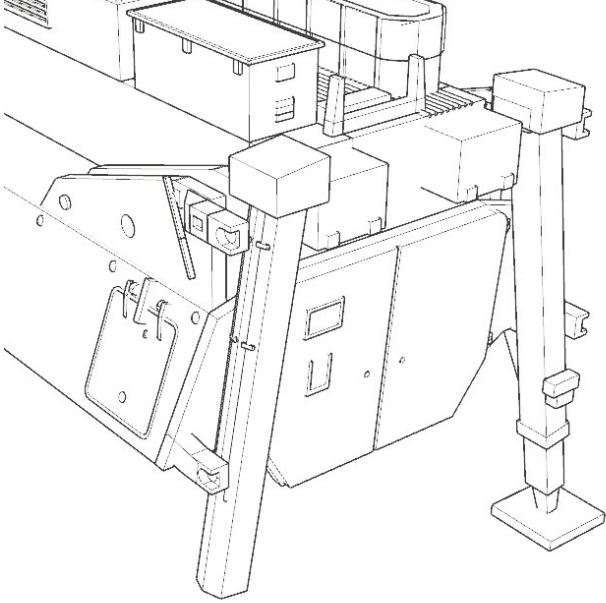
Page 9 Radar. Notice how it is under transportation.



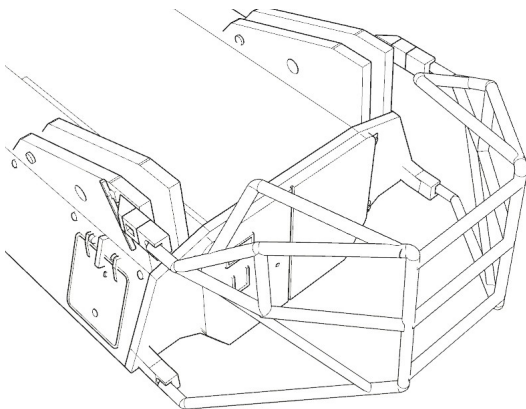
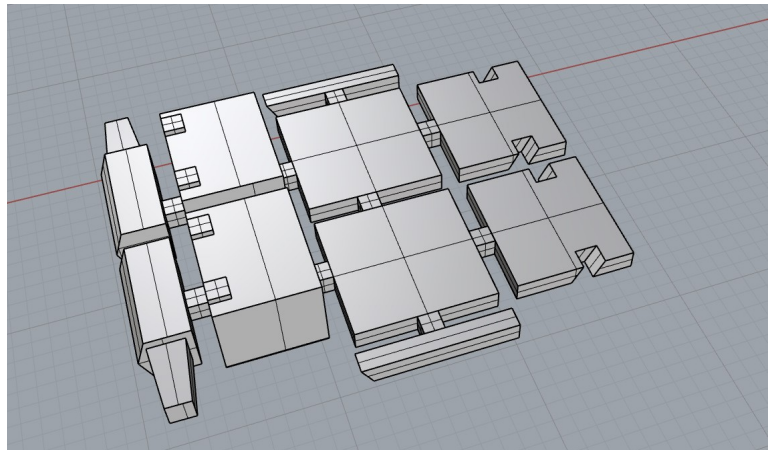
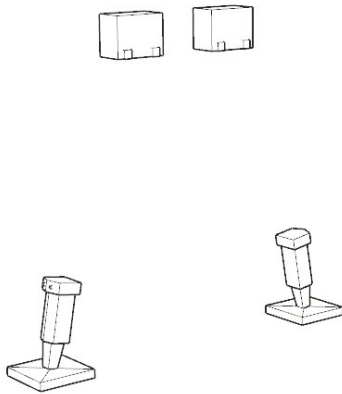

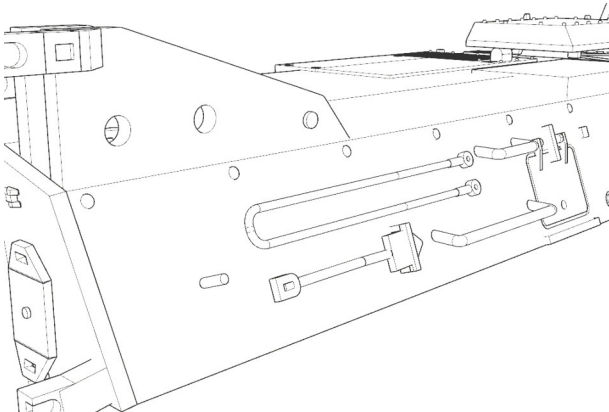


Radar protecting frame under
transportation

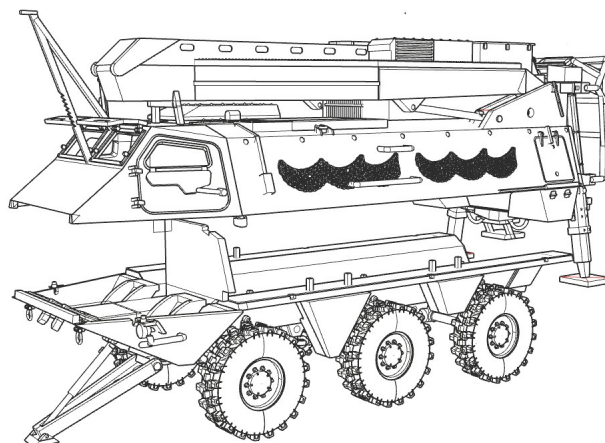


Radar protecting frame is open when operating

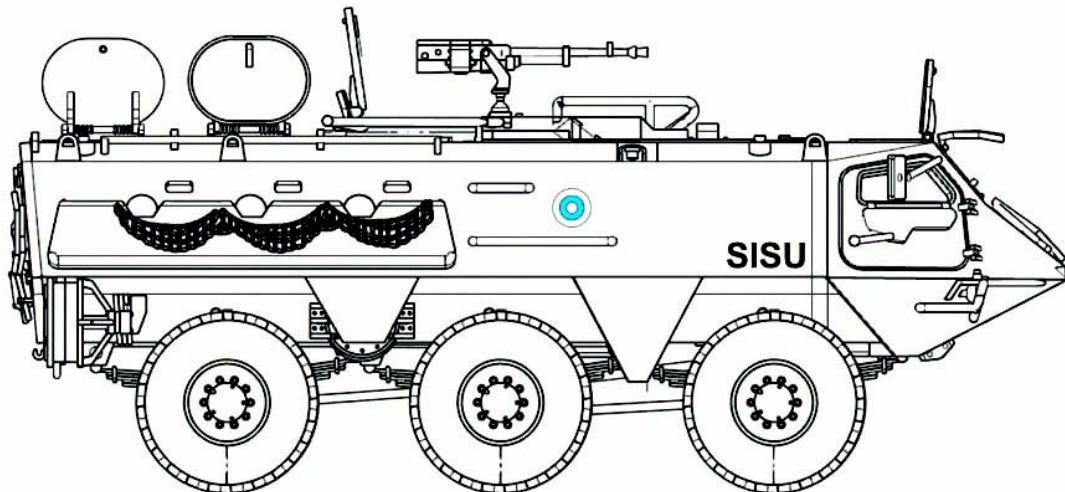
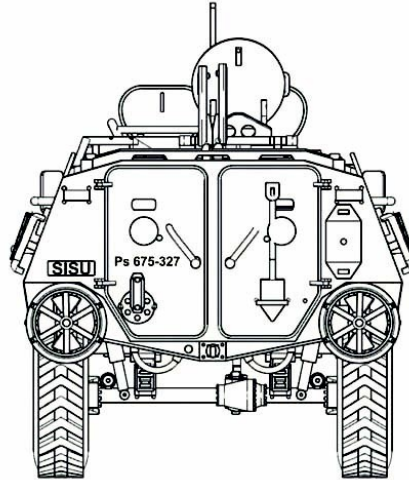
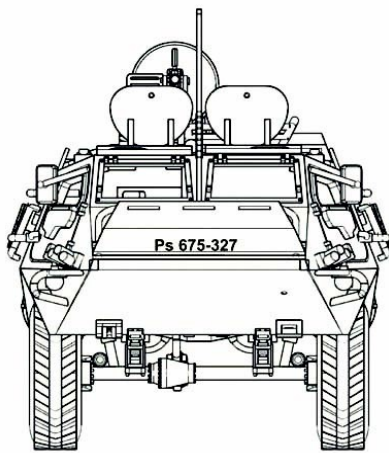
After you have used plastic sheets for windows and tow cable, you can glue parts together. You can also paint vehicle before gluing together.



For paint you can use NATO green
